# Statement of Purpose

Please include a “Statement of Purpose” with the petition for candidacy. This statement will be made available to King Farm Citizens and Titleholders. It will be included in the Chronicle, posted on the website, sent in the email blast, and included in the electronic ballot.

The submitted statement should comply with the following elements:

- 1. No longer than one 8 ½ X 11 sheet.**
- 2. Double-spaced and typed.**
- 3. Font must be 12 point or larger.**

**V. Nominating Signatures**

A valid petition for the Board of Trustees must contain at least **twenty (20) Qualified Citizens**.

Qualified Citizens are (i) at least **18 years** of age, (ii) **registered** with the Assembly as Qualified Voters, and (iii) in **good standing** with the Assembly. To be in good standing, a Qualified Voter must be current (within 30 days of due date) to any financial obligations due to the Assembly. It is recommended that you obtain more than the necessary number of signatures\* in case a Citizen is not in good standing one is not in good standing with the Assembly. **Citizens must sign then legibly print their name and King Farm property address above the line. City, state, and zip code are not necessary.**
